Renewing the psychedelic rock of his idols by adding hints of jazz and soul: that's the challenge Simon Bijaoui set himself when he embarked on his musical career.

A guitarist and singer since the age of 11, Simon draws his inspiration from what he calls the “ world's poetry ”, but also from the dreams he has at night. His world of sound is genuine, poetic and highly visual, both in his lyrics and his instrumentals.

Simon released his debut EP *Girl From the Beyond* in December 2023. He released it on vinyl a few months later, and recorded a Live Session of it at l'Arrière Boutique Studio in June 2024.

What's next? A few singles, including the most recent *Space Explorer* , in preparation for an album in September 2025!



Space Explorer

Simon's latest single, “**Space Explorer**” portrays a space explorer with a thousand stories, traveling to the edge of the universe and through deep space, where it merges with dreams and art.

This track, with its rhythmic rock verses, is interspersed with jazz harmonies in the choruses, where the space explorer confesses his desire to return home. The track ends with a solo and an outro where rock and jazz blend to create a unique and mesmerizing atmosphere.

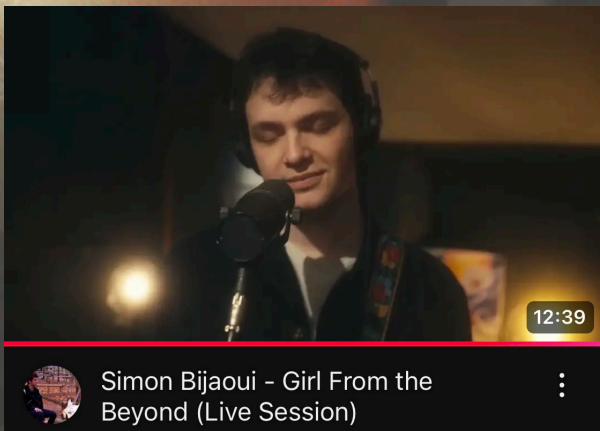
